

Everyone:

- Decide who and how you will complete the surveys. (4.2 and 4.3)
- Select an intergenerational ministry opportunity (4.4)
- Complete Intergenerational Ministry Assessment (4.5)

Children's Ministry Leader:

- Create any materials or information necessary to help parents or other leaders prepare children to participate in an intergenerational worship or learning event
- Work with leaders of the event to make sure children's needs are addressed and gifts are utilized
- Field questions or concerns from parents or children
- Prepare children's ministry leaders for observation opportunity (4.3)
- Distribute and Collect Surveys

Pastoral Leader:

- Create any materials or information necessary to help prepare adults to participate in an intergenerational worship or learning event
- Field questions or concerns, especially from adults unrelated to children's ministries
- Help design surveys

Lay Leader:

- Participate in the intergenerational ministry opportunity as a lay leader
- Help conduct observations of children's ministry areas
